PARKING

As you all know the beginning and the end of the day are extremely busy times for Pensans and Nancealverne Schools. Recently a child at Nancealverne needed an ambulance which was delayed because of parents parking on the sides of the road as well as the pavement.

The safety of children at both schools is our main priority. Emergency service vehicles could be needed at any point in the school day. If they are not able to get to the school as quickly as possible this could cause further injury to a child. We are asking you to only use the spaces that are clearly designated for parking.

Parents who pick up children by car struggle to find parking spaces. One of the provisions we have made is the <u>pickup point</u> where staff collect the children from their class and place them safely in your car. If you travel by car and do not use the pickup point, please ask at the <u>school office</u> for a <u>form</u> so that you <u>can</u> book your slot.

If you are able to leave the car at home and walk with your child/children that would help a great deal.

The closing date for applications is Monday 9th of March and interviews will be held on Friday 13th March


