# PARENT GUIDE SCHOOL UNIFORM



We have a strong expectation that all children attending the school follow our School Uniform and Appearance policy.

Our approach is based upon the following principles;

- We aim to promote a strong, cohesive, school identity that supports high standards and a sense of identity among pupils: if some children look very different to their peers, this can inhibit integration, equality and cohesion
- School Uniform is priced as cheaply as we can afford to sell it, this makes it accessible to all our families and removes the pressure on parents to purchase an alternative 'uniform' directed by peer pressure and fashion.
- Getting children ready for school each day can become a chore particularly if there is a daily debate on what to wear. School uniform removes this debate.
- The sweatshirts are fairly robust and hard-wearing which make them ideally suited to school activities such as art, design technology and playtimes!
- We want children to be proud of belonging to our school community. The wearing of school uniform supports this aim.

Our expectation is that all children will wear school uniform and follow the rules set out below:

- Black Shoes worn to school should be appropriate. High heels and 'flip-flops' are not safe and should not be worn in school.
- Ties are to be worn from Year 1 upwards.
- Training shoes may be worn for PE but should not be worn in place of shoes as they can become an expensive an inappropriate fashion statement for some children.
- We want your child to be safe at all times, therefore, the wearing of jewellery is not permitted.
- Extremes of fashion are not acceptable or appropriate for school either in clothes, footwear, or hairstyle.
- Children are not allowed to bring mobile telephones into school

PE Kits need to be in school from Monday to Friday please.

#### **Other Clothing Requirements**

- A hat (ideally legionnaires style to protect the neck) for use outside especially in the Summer months.
- An art shirt for messy activities (an old oversize T-shirt or shirt is fine).
