Project Overview

We are really excited to welcome the children back this term and are so excited about being back together as a school. During the autumn term we will be learning about Cornwall with a focus on art. We will have three main outcomes for the topic which we will share with a school in France. The children will get the opportunity to visit Mousehole to observe rock pools to create their own rockpool style art. They will also learn the story of the giant 'Comoran' and write their own innovation. Finally the children will learn about and research Barbara Hepworth so that they are able to write her biography.

Reading

Curriculum Links

- * Literacy - Learn and innovate the story of Comoran. They will have the opportunity to research and write a biography for Barbara Hepworth. We will also revise different spellings, punctuation and grammar.
- * Maths - Revise and develop our understanding of number and place value.
- * Art - We will create Rockpool art using a variety of mediums. We will use clay to create sculptures in the style of Barbara Hepworth.
- * DT- Design and make Cornish pasties.
- * PHSE - Virtues and follow the lifewise scheme.
- * Geography- We will use map skills to find Cornwall on a map and learn about the UK.
- * Science - Lifecycles and habitats. We will focus on animals and plants local to our area.
- * PE -Athletics and 30 active minutes.
- * Music - .We will learn about beats and rhythm and practise listening skills.
