Dear Parents and Carers.

I am writing to let you know our plans for staffing and classes next year September 2018 - July 2019. Every year brings changes and we have designed our transition program so that all children will have the opportunity to learn together in their new classes before the end of the term. Teachers and Support Staff will have time to see your child in their current class; teach in their current class alongside their class teacher; spend time and teach your child in their new class and share your child's progress and attainment data.

As you know we have our EYFS unit that has Nursery provision for 2, 3 and 4 year olds and a Reception Class - this will remain unchanged.

In Phase 1 we usually have 3 Year 1/2 classes however next year there will be a Year 1 Class and two Year 2 classes

Phase 2 has three Year 3/4 classes and this will remain the same.

Phase 3 has three Year 5/6 classes and this will remain the same.
