If you have a child in Reception and Phase 1 (Year 1 and 2), they are entitled to a Universal Infant Free School Meal but for a variety of reasons some choose to bring a packed lunch. We would like you to be able take advantage of the cold menu to save you both time and money.

When the weather is fine, children eating the school packed lunch will be able to eat outside.

We would like to invite you to a **packed lunch tasting session on Friday 18th May at 2.30pm** where you will have the opportunity to sample the menu and give feedback.

Check to see if you qualify for Free School Meals!

Eligibility for Free School Meals from Year Three onwards is linked to household income. In February the government announced that children in Year Three and above in England whose parents earn up to £7,400 a year would be entitled to a free school meal.

The more children from Reception to Y6 who are on Free School Meals means the more money we get via Pupil Premium to help improve the attainment of children in school. To check if you are eligible for Free School Meals simply let Mrs Oliver at the school reception know some very basic details: Names, Dates of Birth, National Insurance Number and she will do the rest for you!


Thursday 17th May is a School Census Day and the more Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children who have a school meal that day,




the more funding we attract from the government! So, this coming Thursday will be 'Fish and Chip day' instead of Friday!
