

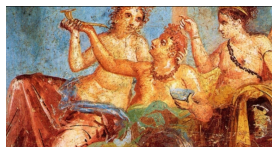
Let's be HISTORIANS!

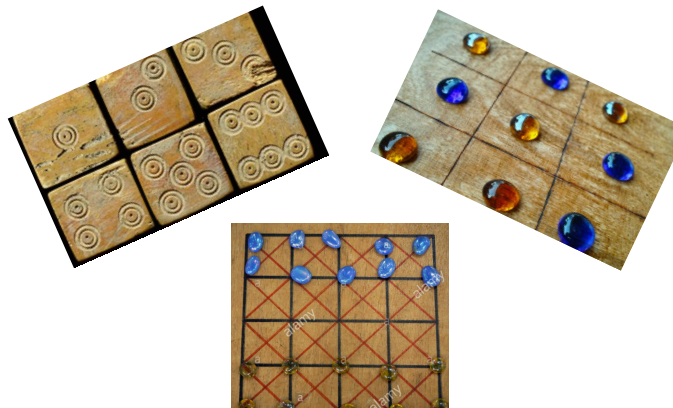
