This week is **anti-bullying week**. Across the country, every school has been focusing on helping children to identify bullying and give them strategies to stop it happening.

I have spent time in each class delivering age appropriate messages about antibullying. We use the word STOP to help children understand what bullying is and children talked about the different unkind behaviours that can cause hurt. These can be: calling a child names; excluding a child from games or conversations; physically hurting or threatening to hurt a child; sending hurtful messages via text or online. None of these behaviours are acceptable in our school community and we consider them to be bullying when they happen Several Times On Purpose.



For us to tackle bullying effectively we need victims to Start Telling Other People. I have asked children to tell an adult that they trust that someone is being bullied or if they are being bullied themselves.

Our virtue this week is RESPECT and this is what our BART for RESPECT looks



If we respect each other, we can help to stamp out bullying.
