We are focusing on improving spelling across the school through a range of strategies. Please ask your child about the games and other methods that help them learn.

We have had a couple of 'near misses' in the carpark at the end of the day. If you are walking with your child please keep to the paths that are signposted so that you and your children are safe and if you are driving please drive slowly with care and attention.

We are delighted that Ellie Baker will be working with our school on a longterm project. The project aims to improve children's emotional well being through a range of activities such as; re-wilding areas of the school, encouraging an increase in pollinating insects such as bees, bugs and butterflies on the school grounds as well as creating a mural of flowering plants that all children will get involved with. Our first event that you can take part in is a 'Dig and Plant' session on Saturday 30th November. The children with Alana and Shona raised £164 from their flash bake sale for seeds and bulbs to plant around the school on the day. Look out for further information in subsequent newsletters.

Pensans has also been selected to pilot the new Restorative Justice program which we will be developing throughout the year. This will give the children and adults in the school the tools to positively manage conflicts and to learn how to resolve differences peacefully.
