Urgent update

There have been a number of outbreaks of Chicken Pox and Scarlet Fever in other schools. The first symptoms of Scarlet Fever include a sore throat and fever which may be accompanied by a headache, nausea and vomiting. This is followed by a distinctive rash. If in any doubt consult a doctor as antibiotics are recommended for anyone affected. Children can return to school 24 hours after starting appropriate antibiotic treatment.
