ParentPay drop in session

All Pensans parents (except Ladybirds) should now have received an introductory letter with their individual usernames and passwords so that they can make payments for their requested payment item(s).

You don't need to have online banking, just a debit card and an email address. There is also a video on the school website which shows how easy it is to set up and use. Just a reminder that children with medical needs eg EPI pens, who require school support, need individual healthcare plans. A healthcare plan is an agreement between parents, the school and healthcare professionals about what care a child needs and how it will be carried out. Templates are available from doctors surgeries. Parents are responsible for drawing up a health care plan and we will help with this. Others who may need to contribute are the school health service, the child's GP or other health care professionals as well as the class teacher or support staff.
