

### **ParentPay**



We have introduced a more convenient way to pay for school meals, trips, after school clubs and much more online, using a secure service called **ParentPay**. From September onwards we will predominantly be a cash free school. All Pensans parents should now have received an introductory letter with their individual usernames and passwords so that they can make payments for their requested payment item(s). Thank you to all parents for their time and patience with setting up their accounts. If you have yet to sign in to your account you will receive a reminder of your username and password in the post in the summer.

#### **Barcodes**

Parents who opt to pay for items with ParentPay barcodes at PayPoint outlets should note that they should only use the barcode relevant to that payment item. Please destroy it after you have used it for a one off payment. Also, only one barcode can be used for one child. If you have more than one child, you need more than one barcode.

Finally, if you overpay when paying via PayPoint, it is not easy or quick to refund the money back to you. It can only be transferred to another payment item when you have one to pay. Please use them with care!

#### Library and reading books

We are still missing a fair few library and reading books. If you have one, please keep it safe and return it on the first day of the school term. Any lost or damaged books will need a £5 contribution from parents for replacements.

#### Avid Reader cards

If your child has nearly finished their Avid Reader stamp card and they wish to continue it next term, please could you take it from their planner/reading record and keep it safe ready for the new school year.

An important reminder to ALL parents but especially those who currently have children in Year 2 or Nursery who are moving into Reception. If you think you may be eligible for **Free School Meals**, please make an application via the county council website. The more parents registered for Free School Meals from Reception through to Year 6, the more Pupil Premium funding our school receives from the Government. Pupil Premium is additional funding which enables our school to provide extra support to children and enable pupils to reach their full potential.

Children who move into Year 3 are no longer eligible for free meals through the Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme, so please ensure you make an application in time for the new term if you think you may be eligible.

Computer and video games have a Pan-European Game Information (PEGI) rating printed on the front of the case. If your child is at Pensans, any game they play or watch should have a green PEGI. Please be aware that playing games out of their age range is a child protection issue and be aware of what they are playing. Even if your child is only watching an older family member playing a game with a 12, 16 or 18 rating, they still are being exposed to unsuitable material.
