#### Dear Parents and Carers,

because of their age. <u>This is especially important</u> if your child is currently in Orange Class (Year 2) as from September these children will not be

<u>eligible for free meals just because of their age</u>. You will need to apply if you think you are eligible because of your income.

Our school also receives Pupil Premium funding for each child on Free School Meals so as well as helping you, it also helps our school.

#### Free School Meals Summer Holiday Vouchers

The government has just announced an extension to the Covid Local Support Grant. As a result we will be ordering a £90 voucher for each Free School Meal eligible pupil - £15 for each of the six weeks of the summer holidays. Vouchers will be ordered from School Vouchers and emailed / text out on the 23rd and 24th July. Cornwall Cricket have teamed up with Active Cornwall and their Time To Move Holiday Programme. Qualifying children can redeem their vouchers on the camps, otherwise they are £10 a day.
