Dear Parents and Carers,

If the test result is positive I will inform Public Health England and they will advise me regarding which children and adults would need to isolate. If your child's bubble needs to isolate you will be notified by text.

If a member of staff or a child develops symptoms of COVID 19 AFTER 3.15pm Sunday 20th December you/they will need to follow NHS guidance and book a test. You will not need to notify Pensans School.
