School Dinners

-Fish and chips will replace the current menu on Thursday 16th January which is a Census Day. We ask parents to help us by encouraging the children to take a school dinner on this day. The Government calculates part of our school funding based on the number of pupils having a school meal on Census Day.



-Week commencing 13/01/2020 is week 1. Weekly menus are on our school website.

-If you think your child may be entitled to Free School Meals, please ask in the office. The form just needs a couple of details and gives extra funding to school too! This applies to Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 even though they get Universal Free School Meals.



Please remember that we offer both before and after school clubs each school day.

Breakfast Club - Children from reception age can be dropped into the hall between 8am and 8:30am. It costs £1.50 a session and includes a varying breakfast menu. No booking necessary.

It is free to *Pupil Premium children (*those children entitled to free school meals based on their family income)

PARC (After-school club) - Open from 3:15pm until 6pm (5pm Fridays). Bookings and prepayments via ParentPay are necessary. Please ask for details at school reception.
